He is coming Victoriously

- Lk.19:11-27
 - Austere (21): hard, harsh, strict in requirement. ...a Pharaoh.
 - Lk.16:27-31, blames God...
 - Why is Lazarus saved?
 - Lk.19: why other servants rewarded?
 - Jn.1:11, first coming...
 - Jn.5:22-23, "honored" Father, not Son

He is coming Personally

- Ac.1:11, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same
 Jesus who was takes up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven"
 - "This Jesus" Mk.14:60-65; Dn.7:13-14
 - ■Jn.8:41
 - Jn.9, no amount of evidence will convince them...

He is coming Visibly

- Ac.1:11 ...will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven
 - "in like manner..." = just as . . .
 - Clouds are vehicle of Deity

He is coming Audibly

- 1 Th.4:16, For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
 - Shout: word of command...always included authority
 - Voice of Archangel
 - Trumpet: 1 Co.15:52, at the last trumpet.
 For the trumpet will sound...

He is coming Unexpectedly

- 1 Th.5:2, For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.
 - Thief: no signs, no date
 - William Miller
 - Hal Lindsey: Late Great Planet Earth
 - God is not bound by time.
 - Amalek, Ex.17:8 . . . 1 Sm.15

He is coming with mighty angels

- 2 Th.1:7-9
 - No one ever led such an army
 - Mt.26:53, more than twelve legions
 - $-6000 \times 12 = 72,000$ +

He is coming in flaming fire

- 2 Th.1:7-9
 - 'In': investiture: invested in, surrounded by (fire).
 - Hb.1:7, angels
 - Hb.10:27, expectation
 - **■**Lv.10
 - Nu.16:35, And a fire came out from the LORD and consumed the two hundred and fifty men who were offering incense

1. Greatest crowd ever assembled

- 2 Co.5:10, 'all' from Adam to end of time
 - Mt.12:41, "The men of Nineveh will rise up in the judgment with this generation, and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and indeed a greater than Jonah is here. 42 "The Queen of the South will rise up in the judgment and condemn it, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and indeed a greater than Solomon is here.
 - Hb.10:25

- 2. Greatest Judge ever to sit on throne
- 2 Tim.4:8, Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.
 - Unjust judges are concerned with bribes, reelection, not justice.
 - Others do not know whole truth; render unjust verdict.
 - Hb.1:9

- 2. Greatest Judge ever to sit on throne
 - Our Judge knows all . . . Gn.18
 - Thoughts, Mt.5:27-28
 - Words, Mt.12:36-37
 - Deeds, Rom.2:6
 - Non-deeds (neglect), Ja.4:17

3. Greatest books ever written

- Jn.12:48
 - Not judged by neighbor's works
 - Not judged by parents' faith
 - Not judged by our feelings
 - Prov.14:12
 - Mt.15:14

- 4. Greatest separation ever known
- Mt.25:31-46
 - Sheep . . . Goats
- 2 Tim.2:19, not a trial to determine guilt or innocence – He already knows
- 2 Th.1:7, 'rest' (relief)
- 2 Th.1:8-9, 'vengeance' (eternal destruction)
 - Some prefer that it offer extremes:

Temporary suffering (purging)

Total annihilation

- 5. Greatest verdict ever pronounced
- Mt.25:46, And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life
 - Eternal decree
