#### 2 Thes. 2:13 – 3:5

- "Everything goes wrong at once"
  - Sometimes true of congregation
    - Some wish for good ole days...
- They had every problem we do…

# I. Paul Gave Thanks, 2:13

#### Mentions all three Persons of Godhead

- Bound ongoing debt (of thanks)
- Give thanks 'always' to God
  - Every day is Thanksgiving
  - Many complain 'always' (Israel)
- Brethren children of same Father; bond
  - -Paul knew it in spite of disobedience (2 Th.3), grief (2 Co.), envy (Phil.1)

"Brotherly love is still the distinguishing badge of every Christian" – Henry

- Beloved by the Lord (ESV; NASB)
  - Not only dear to Paul, but to God
  - Focus on Lord, not persecutors (Ac.7)
- Chosen to salvation –

Past deliverance, 1 Th.5:9

Present process, 1 Tim.1:15

Future hope, 1 Th.5:8

- From the beginning as Ph.4:15 [ASV; NASB]
- Variant: firstfruits [ESV; Gk. NT]

## Through sanctification by the Spirit

- Set apart: holiness, consecration, personal dedication to the interests of the deity
   BDAG
  - -How? Pursue holiness
- Conditions on our part: 1 Th.4:3-7 ('clean house'). 2 Tim.2:21
- Truth: Jn.17:14-17

#### Through sanctification by the Spirit

- And belief in the truth
  - -2 Th.2:10-12, condemned for rejecting truth [= salvation is conditional]
    - Holy Spirit sanctifies
    - We believe truth (a condition we must meet). 1 Th.2:13
      - -Love truth especially when it corrects us. 1 K.22:...16
  - Salvation <u>commences</u> with new birth, <u>continues</u> in maturity of character, <u>culminates</u> in heavenly glory

# Honor to be called by a dignitary The greatest call: 2 Th.1:11 Thanksgiving passes into exhortation

- How? Invited, Mt.22:3-14. 2 Pt.1:10
  - NOT by mystifying experience. GPTG
  - NOT by supernatural whisper
  - NOT through dream or whim
- By (through) gospel, 2:14
  - Divine grace does not exclude obedience. 1:8. 1 Pt.4:17

## Stand fast [firm]

- Firmly committed in conviction or belief BDAG
  - In midst of agitations, defections, false doctrines, be stand firm (pres. imperative)
  - 'Stand' is opposite of vacillating, quitting, getting distracted

'If you don't stand for something, you will fall for anything' - Marshall

#### Hold on [to traditions]

- Instructions handed down by apostles BDAG
  - By word (oral) Ac.17, preaching in Thessalonia
  - By our epistle (written) 1-2 Thes.
    - Oral and written are equally effective
    - Ac.13:27

#### Power comes through...

- Prayer, 16a
  - May… Paul prays for them
- Love of Lord Jesus, of God their love for us (cf. 13)
- Everlasting consolation, 16c comfort that is inexhaustible
- Good hope, 16d Tit.1:2
  - Good: it is real
  - -Ruth 1:12

#### Power comes through...

- Comfort, 17a. Ps.23:4
- Establish, 17b strengthen in every good . . .
  - -Word (all you say). Lk.22:32
  - Work (all you do). Danger: Tit.1:16

## V. Power of Prayer, 3:1-2

#### Paul's request

- Brethren, pray for us (?) 1 Th.3:8
- That word of Lord may run swiftly... [speed ahead; spread rapidly] make rapid linear movement, run, rush, advance. Free course
- And be glorified (honored)
  - Glory belongs to God's word, not to us
  - Thessalonians are babies, but learning –
     eager to obey / share the gospel
  - What does not glorify God's word?
    - Sin, error, grumbling, pride, laziness...

## Paul's request

- Brethren, pray for us
- That word of Lord may run swiftly And be glorified
- As it did also with you
  - Some seek only partial sanctification [Paul writes from Corinth]
  - God speaks as He spoke to Gideon, Jg.6:12

## Paul's request

- Brethren, pray for us
- That word of Lord may run swiftly And be glorified
- As it did also with you
- That we will be delivered from...
  - Unreasonable out of place. Lk.23:41
  - Wicked (evil, wrong, perverse) Ac.17:5 =
     1 Th.2. [Ac.18:...5-11, 12-17]
- Not all have faith. 2:12

   (= 2:17; 1 Th.3:2)
- Guard you: protect by taking careful measures...against evil one (ultimately, against satan). Ja.4:7

#### May...

- Lord direct your hearts
  - Many are directionally challenged including some in Thessalonia
  - Divine effect of gospel: lead, direct;
     concentrate heart in thought, will, emotions
    - We must think right to live right
    - We think right by knowing His Word

#### May...

- Lord direct your hearts
- Into the love of God
  - Human response to gospel: love of God
  - Grow in understanding His love
    - in appreciation of it
    - in practice of it

#### May...

- Lord direct your hearts
- Into the love of God
- Into the patience of Christ
  - Steadfastness (ESV; NASB)
  - Endurance of Christ serves as our example
    - Christlike fortitude
