## 1. Peter is not a bad person

- Left all to follow Jesus, Mt.19:27
- More zeal than knowledge, Ro.10:1-3
- Kept falling <u>because</u> kept getting up
- Not afraid to try anything, Mt.14 / 26
- Not alone: every other disciple failed

#### 1. Peter is not a bad person

## 2. Peter did some things right

- Walked on water (courage: left boat)
- Believed Lord's power (Mt.8:27; Lk.5:8). Mt.10
- Walked to Jesus, not away from Him
- Learned from his mistakes

Acts 2, preached truth to hostile audience Acts 3-5, stood w/o compromise... Acts 12

- 1. Peter is not a bad person
- 2. Peter did some things right

# 3. Peter sank because of . . .

'little faith' (31)

- Mt.6:30

- Mt.8:26

- Mt.16:8

Faith easier to profess than practice

Little faith seen in three ways

- 1. Peter is not a bad person
- 2. Peter did some things right

#### 3. Peter sank . . . little faith

- 1) Focus (30): he saw wind / waves...
  - He did not launch boat w/o Lord's command or jump rashly into sea (29)
  - He let wind/waves take eyes off Jesus
  - Hb.12:2, our focus? (Nu.21)

Mt.14: to walk on water, Peter must:

- 1. Trust, not doubt
- 2. Travel, not despair
- 3. Triumph, not decline

Mt.26, to remain loyal to Christ...
must Trust....

Lord could use Peter. Jn.21 Ac.2; 4:13; 1 Pt.5:10

- 1. We relate to Peter
- 2. Peter kept falling, but kept getting up
- 3. Lord saw disciples' trouble / anguish
  No one else could . . .
  - 1. have seen them (1 Pt.3:12). Perception
  - 2. come to them (no boat). Power
  - 3. help them after coming. Permission
  - 4. have <u>waited</u> so long (Jn.11). <u>Patience</u>
