## What Does Faith Do?

## 2 Pt.2:5, eighth

- Noah, with seven others (lit., 'as the eighth')
  - Not eighth from Adam
  - Stresses a low number (few, 1 Pt.3:20)
  - Noah's faith (like Abel and Enoch) also includes future events – unheard of
  - 2. Enoch walked with God as world slid into corruption...

Noah walked with God when world was at its worst

# I. By Faith We Prepare For Judgment

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25 (Jesus, v.24)
  - 1. God did <u>not</u> force people to prepare for the Flood. Free will
  - 2. God did force a choice. Doing nothing is a choice. Josh.24:15
  - 3. Choice brings consequences: blessing or punishment.
  - 4. Noah's decision . . .

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25
  - 4. Noah's decision was not determined by . . .
    - a. Numbers. Only family boarded ark...
    - b. Logic. Ship on dry land? World-flood? Scientists...? Looked ridiculous...
    - c. Desire. Most want to stay in sin...
    - d. Relatives (living / dead). Saved w/o ark...
    - e. Visible evidence. 'Things not yet seen.' No sign of rain. Mountain-high flood?? [2 Pt.3:5-7, same word...]
    - f. Earthly blessings and pleasures.

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25
  - God did not force people to prepare for the Flood. Free will
  - 2. God did force a choice. Doing nothing is a choice. Josh.24:15
  - Choice brings consequences: blessing or punishment
  - 4. Noah's decision was not determined by . . .
  - 5. We either believe or we don't
  - 6. Noah motivated by faith: believed God

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25
- Attitude: Godly fear. 5:7; 12:28; 11:7
- Action: Prepared ark
  - Favorite word for construction of ships
  - Moved by godly fear . . . obeyed . . . prepared ark . . . saved family . . . condemned world (. . . Hb.11:7, <u>by words</u> . . . 2 Pt.2:5, <u>by example</u>)

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25
- Attitude: Godly fear
- Action: Prepared ark
- Aim: <u>Salvation</u> of family
  - -Gn.5:32, Noah, age 500 ... became father ...
  - -Gn.7:6, age 600, flood came
  - Spent 100+ years to fulfill a single command of God
    - "By which"? Faith? Ark? Salvation?
    - Hb.10:30, equally dangerous for readers

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25
- Attitude: Godly fear
- Action: Prepared ark
- Aim: Salvation of family
- Achievement:
  - Judged world: 2 Pt.2:5, by preaching
    - Lot (Gn.19:1, 14)
    - Noah's audience: worst sinners, Gn.6:5
    - Noah judged by example. Mt.12:41;
      1 Pt.4:4

- Admonition: divinely warned. Hb.8:5; 12:25
- Attitude: Godly fear
- Action: Prepared ark
- Aim: Salvation of family
- Achievement:
  - -Judged world: 2 Pt.2:5, by preaching
  - Heir of righteousness:
    - Gn.6:9, already righteous
    - Hb.11:7, became righteous
    - 2 Pt.2:5, preacher of righteousness

- Righteous: Gn.6:9. Ezk.14:14, 20
- Blameless: complete, sound; without blemish
- Walk with God: Gn.6:9. Am.3:3
- Strict obedience: Faith w/o works... Ja.2:26
  - Command: Gn.6:14, ark . . . Gopher
  - Details: Gn.6:3
    - 120 years preparation, hard labor
    - Preaching ... no positive results
    - Worked to support family
    - Spiritual training of family shared faith

## III. NT Parallels

- Foreshadows coming of Christ, sudden judgment, Mt.24:37-39
- Noah saved by grace, Gn.6:8. Ep.2:8
- Noah saved by faith, Hb.11:7. Ep.2:8
- Noah saved by obedience, Gn.6:9,22. Hb.5:9
- Noah saved by water, 1 Pt.3:20. 1 Pt.3:21

At the very time God was preparing judgment, He was preparing a way of escape.

Noah warned sinners for 120 years. 2 Pt.3:10

- 1. Noah took God at His word
- 2. Noah was not deterred by mockery or unbelief
- 3. Hb.11:7, Noah's faith saved him and his family
  - Faith may save readers from destruction
  - Hb.10:39 tired, abused, tempted to quit
  - Remedy: faith (10:32-37)
  - Noah walked with God even in darkest days

- 4. Faith cost Abel his life...but gave him the greatest gain . . .
  - Enoch was taken from this life . . . another gain
    - . . . Noah saved family's life
