## Corban

### Three kinds of religious people

- 1. Hear but do not obey
- 2. Hear and obey
- 3. Hear, obey, then add to the Word

- 1: Pharisees and scribes: posse from Jerusalem
  - Mk.6:53-56
  - Pharisees ... came to attack Lord (3:6)
- 2: Saw disciples eating with defiled (unwashed) hands. Defiled: six times (2, 15, 18, 20, 23)
  - a. Not bad manners, but uncleanness: sin
  - b. Rabbis: feared attacks of demon, Shibta; liable to poverty and destruction...
  - c. They view Jesus as great deceiver

- Man-made laws in religion are not new Mk.7
- 3: official (Scriptural) position: Jews do not eat unless they wash hands 'in a special way'...
  - a. Tradition of elders: legal experts of old days
  - b. Oral law . . . later, the Mishnah
  - c. Pharisees regarded traditions handed down by great teachers as equal to Scripture
- 4: Market was especially defiling...
  - a. Gentile might brush against a Jew...
  - b. This is religious purification, not health issue
  - c. Mishna: 30 chapters on cleansing of vessels

- Man-made laws in religion are not new Mk.7
- 5: Jews go on offensive: "Your disciples" hold Jesus accountable for sins against Law
- 6-7: Isa.29:13 (Jews repeat OT sins)
  - a. Lord's focus: they are hypocrites
  - b. rabbis enormously increased regulations...
    - 1) lip service
    - 2) heart is far away
    - 3) worship in vain
    - 4) teach doctrines of men (v.3: elders)

Man-made laws in religion are not new – Mk.7 8: substitute tradition for God's law. Apostasy

A fence around the law actually replaces the Law

Scholars can be basest of people: proud, dishonest, prejudiced, unbelieving

- 9: they do a great job of rejecting . . .
  - a. 6:26: do not recognize; declare invalid...
  - b. that you may keep your tradition
- 10: Jesus turns to Scripture (< Moses)
  - a. Pharisees turn to tradition (v.5)
  - b. Scripture: 1400 years old; binding...
- 11-12: "but you say..." [emphatic]. (Cf. v.9)
  - a. Assume they are greater than Moses (10)
  - b. Corban: gift to God; an escape of duty...
- 13: make void, nullify. Papyri: annulling contracts

- 14-16: addresses common people
  - a. Don't have to be expert in law to know truth
  - b. Nothing from outside defiles?
- 17-19: Mt.15:12-14 You offended the Pharisees
  - Instead of apologizing, Jesus describes them and their tradition as a plant . . . Uprooted
  - 17: curious hearts want to know
  - 18: honest hearts wants to get it right
  - 19: <u>true</u> hearts are not afraid of truth.
     He purified all foods

### 20-23: warning to disciples

- a. Beware of sins: they do defile
- b. 21: From the heart all sin begins in thoughts

Food is not digested in the heart; but what comes out of the mouth begins in the heart. This is what defiles people.

## I. Hypocrisy is Wrong

### Jewish worship

Designed to give outward impression of great devotion to God

But their rules allowed them to evade, dodge the responsibilities of true faith . . .

Encouraged them to swell up in pride

- Mt.6:2-4...5...16-18
- Lk.18:9-14

## Some who are inwardly corrupt appear outwardly religious

Pharisees pretended concern for God's law, but tried to kill God's Son! (Ex.20:13)

Some 'Christians' hate, envy, hold grudges, nourish bitterness, pride ... but think they are safe because . . .

- 1. they attend regularly
- 2. others do bad things too
- 3. they do a lot of good things
- 4. nobody's perfect

Pharisees also loved excuses

## II. Hypocrisy is a Common Source of Human Doctrines

# Jews used human tradition to shield hypocrisy Many traditions and doctrines exist today...

- 1. Roman Catholicism: asceticism [abstained from marriage, foods, pleasure...] Gave appearance of great dedication... Ph.2:14-15
- 2. Mechanical music in worship: organ...gives impression of fervent religious activity. Ep.5:19
- 3. Institutionalism: HOT programs encouraged Christians to appreciate the great religious religious activity of sponsoring churches...

"Unfortunately, there are many 'evangelical traditions' in churches today, man-made teachings that are often considered as authoritative as the Word of God – even though they contradict His Word"
